Religious Education News

Registration for Religious Education will be held before and after the 10:30 Masses each Sunday. Any child 1st through 6th Grade, who is not a student of MCPS, is required to attend our once a month Home Based Religious Education Program. Our 1st Meeting of Religious Education is September 5th from 9:15 am to 10:15 am.

PARENTS, PLEASE, ATTEND THIS MEETING WITH YOUR CHILD SO THAT YOU CAN UNDERSTAND YOUR PART IN OUR PROGRAM.

Classes in *Catholicism* are on Thursday, at 6:30 PM in OLQM parish hall. The Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church is the textbook. These classes are for potential converts to the Catholic Church, for those simply seeking information on Catholicism, and for Catholics who wish to deepen their understanding of the Faith. These classes satisfy the requirements for the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA). Father Sreboth is the teacher.

The *Gospel of Mark* is taught each Wednesday. Study time is at 9 AM & repeats again at 6:30 PM. Classes will continue through mid-December. Books are available at classes. The cost is \$10. The text is from the Ignatius Study Bible series by Dr. Scott Hahn. Father Michael Sreboth teaches these classes in the OLQM parish hall.

Child Protection - any parishioner who has substantial contact with the young people of the Parish in any Volunteer or Paid position must have Child Protection Training. The next class will be held at Montgomery Catholic High School, Sept 27th at 6:30pm.

If you have already taken the class, you must participate in the on-line retraining. This retraining is required of all personnel who have already completed their initial C.A.P.P. training and who continue to be active in the ministries of the Archdiocese of Mobile. Log on to www.mobilearchdiocese.org. The retraining articles will be found on the Office of Child Protection page. After reading the articles, take the quiz. You will receive immediate feedback as to whether or not you pass the quiz. The online database will be automatically updated with the new retraining expiration date. Thank you for your help in this endeavor to keep our kids safe!
