In the Mass on Thanksgiving Day, the prayers & preface interpret the American understanding of this celebration. The biblical readings are appropriate to the theme of Thanksgiving.

Upon sufficient reflection spent in adoration & contrition, we are then disposed to thank God for creating us, keeping us in existence, & the gifts & traits that he gives us. The secular feast of Thanksgiving Day is then situated in the context of these 4 ways of communicating with God.
